TO OVERCOME PROBLEM OF USING PUNCTUATION IN SENTENCES.

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Background study.

CAPITAL LETTER must be used for:

- first letter from the first word of a sentence.
- the first letter of a proper nouns (person's name, place)

Full stop is use at the end of sentences.

Malay language composition test (Year 3)
-pupil have to rewrite the sentences given
using the correct punctuation.

Previous reflection on teaching & learning.

Azrizam, a Year 3 pupil often scores the highest mark for Malay language comprehension test but fail in Malay language composition test.

Diagram1: Marks scored by Azrizam in the first term exam (10 March, 2009).

Test analysis indicates that **he did not answer any questions** that test the use of punctuation
(five questions = 20 marks).

Focus of the study.

My pupil encounter a problem of using punctuation correctly. How can I help him to understand the correct use of punctuation?

Questions:

- 1) Does the method effective in helping the pupil to use the punctuation correctly?
- 2) Does the pupil manage to correct punctuation in the sentences given?

Objective of the study.

The objective of this study is that pupils can:

- 1. Use the correct punctuation in sentences
- 2. Correct punctuation error in the sentences given.



Target of the study.

Azrizam a/l Azamudin, a Year 3 pupil of SK Bukit Gemuruh, Bera, Pahang.

The Action Research Model.

Kemmis and Taggart Model (1992)

Focus of the study.

-Pupil cannot use punctuation correctly in sentences.

Findings.

-Pupils can use the correct punctuation in sentences.

Data collection.

- -Pre-test
- -Post-test
- -Worksheet (exercise)

-Q&A

Action Planning.

-The 'Traffic Light Method' (using green, orange & red colour pencil in writing the punctuation).

Implementation of action.

- Teacher explains the use of colour pencil in writing the punctuation.
- -Pupils demonstrate using green, orange and red cards.
- Pupils do exercises-using colour.

Action planning.

WEEK 1

Introduction (60 minutes)

- Teacher explains the 'Traffic Light Method'.
- 2. Demonstration using colour cards.
- Pupils write 5 sentences using 'Traffic Light Method'.

Enhancement session (30 minutes)

- 1. Discussions.
- 2. Pupils are asked to correct the punctuation using the 'Traffic Light Method'.

Post-test I (30 minutes)

Pupils answer the test questions.

WEEK 2

Enrichment session (30 minutes)

Pupils answer the test questions.

Post -test II (30 minutes)

Pupils answer the test questions.

Implementation of the programmed.

1. Few pupils are asked to hold cards to form a complete sentence.



2. Pupils read aloud the sentence.

- 3. A selected pupil is given **green**, **orange** and **red** card.
- 4. He is required to give:
 - Green card to pupil who holds the first card (first word of the sentence),



- Orange card to pupil who holds the card with the names of persons,



-Red card to pupil who hold the last card (full stop).




5. Pupils who hold **green**, **orange** & **red** card left **standing**, holding the other cards required **squatting**.




6. The selected pupil rewrites the sentence with the correct punctuation.



7. Pupils explain about the use of punctuation.







Findings.

Pre-test analysis (6 April, 2009).

During the test, Azrizam:

- > read and stared at the question paper.
- > took about 10 minutes before start to answer the questions.
- scratching and holding his head while answering questions.
- ❖ He did not understand the requirements of the questions.

"There's nothing wrong with the spelling, teacher. These spellings are all correct."





Pre-test analysis.

- ➤ He got 20% marks.
- > Of the 6 sentences given, only one sentence begins with capital letter.
- > All nouns (person's name) are written in small letters.
- ➤ Only 2 sentences have full stop at the right place.
- 3 sentences did not have any full stop.

Example of mistakes made by Azrizam in pre-test.

Post-test I (10 April 2009)

- ➤ He got 42% marks.
- > He put the full stop correctly in all five sentences.

Exercise (16 April 2009)

- nama saya azrizam.
- saya dan ahmad suka berlari Saja dan Ahmad Suka berlari
 - 3. cikqu siti tinggal di situ-

Post-test II (17 April 2009)

Marks scored: 80%

- 2. saya dan zaki membantu seorang nenek tua Saya dan Zaki Membantu Scolan hehek tua.
- adik memetik sekuntum bunga di taman itu

 Adik Memetik Sekuntum bunga di

 Tamah itu.
- 4. encik raju ada sebuah kereta bewarna kuning Encik Ralu ada Sebuah (Releta hewarna Buning)

Reflection of the research.

The 'Traffic Light Method' (the use of green, orange and red colour pencil) has been successful because Azrizam loves colouring and wants to be a police traffic.

The use of colour has made him understand and remember the correct use of punctuation.

Azrizam still did some mistakes while writing but he has show much improvement. He is more confident to answer the punctuation exercises.

Suggestion for further research.

This study was **limited** only to punctuation that involves the use of full stops and capital letters for the first letter of the sentence and the person's name.

The use of capital letter for other noun that names a specific place or thing was **not involved**.

Therefore, a study can be done to use other colours for the punctuation of other noun.
