## OEC Organized the Work Shop on Budget Plan Integration to Mobilize the Education Reform with Relevant Administrations.



On 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2011 the OEC organized the Work shop on the budget plan to expedite the Education Reform in the Second Decades (2012-2018) in accordance with the 10 urgent policies, in 4 main points with participants from relevant administrations. The Work shop focused on work integration in order to avoid the overlapping routine works, the outcomes of which will be proposed thereon to the Sub Committee of the Education Reform in the Second Decade (2012-2018) on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011.

Ms. Wattana Artidtieng, Director of Macro Educational Policy Bureau, at the opening speech, reported that in conducting the budget plan for Education Reform in the Second Decade, the data and information gathering from relevant administrations were concluded in 4 main points as follows: 1. New learning process and main hosts are OBEC and OVEC. 2. New generation of teachers and shortage of specialized teachers and main hosts are OHEC and OVEC. 3. Education institutes and new learning sources and main hosts are OPS-MoE. 4. New Management and main host is OEC. In order to avoid the overlapping with the routine works, OEC has invited more than 60 personnel from concerned administrations for a collective integration since some projects may be extended from the original ones of which will necessitate the use of budget or not.

The conclusion reached at today's Work shop will be submitted accordingly to the Sub-Committee for Education Reform Budget Plan in the Second Decade (2012-2018) during the meeting to be held on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 and chaired by Mr. Chaiyos Chirametakorn, Deputy Minister of Education.
