HISTORY

- 1908 Established as University of the Philippines
- 1972 Reorganized into the UP System
- 2008 Chartered as the National University

7 Constituent Universities

- One autonomous college
- 15 campuses nationwide
- 175 undergraduate degree programs

>53,000 students (2014)

EQUITY and INCOME

- APPLICANTS For UPCAT 2015 from different income categories have equitable distributions (approx 30%)
- A smaller percentage of the Qualifiers came from lower income groups
- Lowest income group has lowest qualifying rate (10.44); Highest income group has highest qualifying rate (24.8%)



FRESHMAN ADMISSIONSEQUITY and High School TYPE


Applicants from general Public HS went up slightly from 27% in 2011 to 30.57% in 2015

The Qualifying rate of Private HS applicants is 14.32%; for Public HS it is 15.32%

Only 7% of Applicants are from Public Science HS but they make up nearly 20% of Qualifiers
