

Announcement of Office of the Education Council No Gift Policy Fiscal Year B.E 2567 (2024)

In Accordance with to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018) Section 128 stipulates that government official shall not receive property or any other benefits that may be calculated as income from anyone, except for property or benefits that should be obtained according to laws, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of the law, unless the receiving of property or any other benefits through ethics according to the criteria and amounts specified by the National Anti-Corruption Commission. Moreover, the Cabinet resolution on December 8, 2020, approved the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revised edition) which include important reform activities (Big Rock), Activity 4: Developing the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and benefitless Goal no.1, Section 1.1: all government agencies shall announce the policy that government officials do not accept gifts and presents from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy)

To strengthen organization culture and values of honesty in performing duties with morality, ethics and corruption prevention, office of the Education Council announces its No Gift Policy determining that all personnel of office of the Education Council in every level from the Executive to staff shall receive no gifts and benefits from performing their duty as following;

- 1. Do not accept all kinds of gifts and presents both before and after performing duties, which will result in corruption and misconduct.
 - 2. Do not seek to obtain gifts, presents, or any other unlawful benefits.
 - 3. Do not give property or any other benefits to visitors while performan duties.
- 4. Civil servants and personnel of the Office of the Education Council have duty to inform third party of the No Gift Policy.
- 5. In cases where it is necessary to give or receive property or any other benefits according to ethics or normal customs. All personnel must follow the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by officials of the state, B.E. 2565 and the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for receiving property or other benefits through the ethics of state officials, B.E. 2563
