



Announcement of Office of the Education Council
No Gift Policy Fiscal Year 2026

According to the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128 stipulates that public officials are prohibited from accepting assets or any other benefits which may be calculated in monetary value from any person except for the assets or benefits which may be entitled to such persons under the laws, regulations or rules permitted by virtue of law, unless the acceptance of assets or other benefits is on ethical basis under the criteria and amount as prescribed by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC). On 8th December, 2020, the Cabinet approved the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revised edition). Under Big Rock Activity 4, “Developing the Thai public administration system to meet transparency and freedom from conflicts of interest,” Goal 1, Item 1.1 requires all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies in which all public officials refuse to accept any gifts or gratuities of all kinds for the performance of duties (No Gift Policy).

To enhance organizational culture and integrity for moral and ethical performance of duties, the Office of the Education Council is required to be an agency in which all government officials refuse to accept any gifts or gratuities of all kinds resulting for the performance of duties (No Gift policy). Therefore, executives, government officials, and staff of the Office of the Education Council must comply with as follows:

1. Refrain from accepting gifts or gratuities of all kinds before, during, or after the performance of duties as it will lead to corruption and misconduct.
2. Refrain from seeking any unlawful gifts, gratuities, or other benefits.
3. The government officials and staff of the Office of the Education Council must inform outsiders of this Policy.
4. Any ethical or traditional giving or accepting assets or other benefits must strictly comply with the Regulation of the Office of the Prime Minister on Giving or Acceptance of Gifts of Government Officials B.E. 2565 (2022) and the Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Code of Ethics for Acceptance of Assets or Other Benefits for Government Officials, B.E. 2563 (2020)
